When I read that line above my first thought was that I could easily replace the word 'drinking' with words like 'time', or 'plans', or 'desires'.

I have to be vigilant on a daily basis in looking at my motives. Selfish self-centered thinking causes my resentments, every time. Thinking about me, me, me.

The solution for me is to practice doing the opposite of my initial response. If someone asks for some of my time, I stop - pause, if you will - and consider ALL alternatives.

"Is what I want or need to do actually something that needs to be done right now, or can it wait an hour or two? Or even a day or two?"

"Will the world end if I don't get to do that thing I planned to do?"

"Will I be okay if I don't get that thing I wanted?"

When I pause and ask myself questions like these, I can come from a place of consideration instead of from a place of self-will.

Each old, negative behavior I've practiced that no longer serves me or others can be replaced with a new, positive behavior that does serve others, if I take the time to consider my motives and the contrary action. Working Steps Six and Seven keeps me out of self-will and connected to my Higher Power.
